

LRAFC 100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the Liverpool Ramblers AFC.

RULES

- 1. For a cost of £2 per month you will be allocated an LRAFC 100 Club number. More than one number may be obtained by any individual.
- 2. While termed the LRAFC 100 Club, the draws will commence when at least 50 people have joined. The commencement of the draw will be publicised on the members' section the LRAFC website and by email circular to participants.
- 3. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
- 4. The prizes will total 50% of the monthly contributions received, apportioned 1st prize 30%, 2nd prize 15% and 3rd prize 5%.
- 5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is only open to members of LRAFC, plus their friends and family. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 6. Contributions must be made by monthly standing order to the LRAFC 100 Club bank account. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- 7. Member's numbers will only be entered in to a monthly draw if their contribution is received.
- 8. The draw shall be made by the club President, or if he is unavailable a delegated member of the club Committee, on the second Saturday of each month following commencement.
- 9. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be publicised on the members' section of the club website and by email circular.
- 10. The prizes will be paid to winners direct to the bank account the related standing order was paid from before the end of the month that the draw was made.
- 11. The LRAFC 100 Club is run by the Club Committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final, with the President having a casting vote in the case of a split Committee decision.
- 12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the LRAFC 100 Club if his/her contributions are unpaid for a period of one month.
- 13. If a payment of winnings to the account the related standing order was paid from can't be made or is returned and the winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be remain in the club funds and be forfeited after a period of 6 months unless the winner makes contact with the Hon. Treasurer. It is the participants' responsibility to advise the club of any changes to the contact details supplied in their application form.
